WELCOME TO MIAMI SHORES!

Miami Shores got its start in 1925 when developer Hugh Anderson began developing "America's Mediterranean." In an area just north of Miami with acres of farms, pineapple fields, avocado and mango groves, a planned community of beautiful homes, landscaped streets and recreational facilities was constructed.

The Florida real estate bust almost hit Miami Shores, but Bessemer Properties took control of the development and by 1932, the area was growing again. It became incorporated as Miami Shores, "The Village Beautiful."

Today, the 10,000 plus residents remain dedicated to preserving the quality of life the Village's founders envisioned.

Miami Shores brings the small town feel to the big city. The northeast Miami-Dade location provides easy access to South Florida's major expressways making much of the areas activities just a short drive away.

Miami Shores provides year round recreation programs and special events. In addition, the Miami Shores Country Club offers tennis, fine dining and a traditional 18-hole championship golf course. Check out a book at Brockway Memorial Library. Educational opportunities

WHERE DO YOUR TAX DOLLARS GO?

Miami Shores Village's share of the average overall property tax bill is approximately 30%. In other words, for every property tax dollar paid by property owners in Miami Shores, the Village receives 30 cents.

The remainder goes to the other taxing authorities that include the Miami-Dade County School Board, Miami-Dade County, the Miami-Dade County Fire and Rescue Department, South Florida Water Management

District, Florida Inland Navigation District, Everglades construction Project and the Children's Trust Authority.

Also included on the property tax bill are fees for non ad valorem assessments for sanitation and storm water fees.
