Registration Fee applies the Friday before start.




READ WITH GRACIE, the Golden Doodle Therapy Dog!

COUNCIL INFORMATION

REGULAR COUNCIL MEETINGS

The December 2019 meeting will be held on Tuesday, December 3rd at 6:30 PM at Village Hall. The Village Council will not have a second meeting in December. Meetings will still air on Channel 77 at 7 PM on Monday, Wednesday, and Fridays following the Council Meeting or may be viewed via the Village website at www.msvfl.gov.

RECENT COUNCIL ACTION

- Designated NE 105 Street from NE 10 Court to NE 11 Court as a resident-only parking permit area.
- Extended the Sculpture Garden Display at Optimist Park for two years.
- Approved Green Day discount of \$4,500 to the Greater Miami Shores Chamber of Commerce for Village in-kind services.
- Ratified the Federation of Public Employees collective bargaining agreement effective October 1, 2019.
- Endorsed the Resilient305 Strategy, agreeing to consider collaborating to implement the Strategy in whole or in part as appropriate for Miami Shores.
- Approved resolution creating budget amendment #6 to the fiscal year 2018-2019 operating budgets, increasing revenues and effectuating transfers to reverse the year end budget deficit.
- Approved resolution creating budget amendment #1, 2 and 3 to the fiscal year 2019-2020 operating budgets.
- Approved resolution, authorizing the village manager to execute the community planning technical assistance grant agreement documents and to administer the grant.
- Declared the Village "Friends of the Trail" regarding future development of the Flagler Trail through Miami Shores and authorized the Village Manager to explore grant possibilities in addition to formalizing the initiative.
