



COUNCIL INFORMATION

The July 2020 meetings will be held virtually at 6:30 PM on Tuesday, July 7th and 21st via livestream. Council Budget Workshop will be held on Tuesday, July 14 at 6 PM, virtually.

RECENT COUNCIL ACTION

- Presented Dr. Kelly Andrews, Executive Director of Doctors Charter School, with a proclamation in honor of her exceptional service to Doctors Charter School.
- Approved resolution, authorizing the Village Manager to execute the turf and landscape maintenance contract renewal between the Florida Department of Transportation and Miami Shores Village.
- Directed the Village Manager to suspend the engagement of a land use consultant to consider alternate use for the Miami Shores Country Club & Golf Course (MSCC), and to postpone issuing the competitive solicitation for the management of the MSCC until the market recovers.
- Directed the Village Manager and Village Attorney to negotiate an agreement between Professional Course Management and the Village and to bring forth the proposed agreement for Council consideration while staff continues to work on the competitive solicitation document.
- Approved resolution, providing for consideration and approval of the uniform method of levy, collection and enforcement of non-ad valorem assessments of the Water and Sewer System that serves the Village commercial area on NE 2nd Avenue.
- Approved Resolution, urging Miami-Dade County Mayor Carlos Gimenez and the Board of County Commissioners to transfer CARES Act funds to the Village.
- Approved Resolution, adopting the Miami Shores Sewer Facility Plan for the Shores Estates Subdivision.
- Appointed Nancy Cigno, John Rosenquest, Resa Strickland and Georgios Yiannikakis to the Doctors Charter School Board.
- Awarded RFP 2020-04-01 for the multimodal improvements on NE 2nd avenue from 103 street to 111 street to Metro Express, Inc.
