


MARCH 2020 HOUSE OF THE MONTH


The Miami Shores Village House of the Month showcases a range of project types, styles & budgets & supports the Village's vibrant community.

Please be aware that placing debris over storm drains is not only a safety concern during a rain storm, it is also a violation of our Code of Ordinances: Sec. 20-107.



REGULAR COUNCIL MEETINGS

The March 2020 meetings will be held on Tuesday, March 3rd and Tuesday, March 17th at 6:30 PM at Village Hall. Meetings air on Channel 77 at 7 PM on Monday, Wednesday and Friday following the Council Meeting or may be viewed via the Village website at www.msvfl.gov.

RECENT COUNCIL ACTION

- Adopted the Ordinance on Second Reading, establishing a Sustainability and Resiliency Committee.
- Approved Ordinance on First Reading as amended, regulating single-use plastic bottled water in any Village facility or on village property and exceptions.
- Adopted Ordinance 2020-02, regulating single-use plastic bottled water in any village facility or on Village property.
- Endorsed the Resilient305 Mayor's Accord & Pledge.
- Authorized the Village Manager to pursue the Florida Inland Navigation District (FIND) Grant to construct a new seawall launching ramp at Bayfront Park.
