

RECENT COUNCIL ACTION

Miami Shores Village Council Adopts Millage Rates and Passes Fiscal Year 2019 Budgets

The Council held two Public Hearings on the proposed millage rates and budgets on September 4 and September 17, 2018 thereby setting the new millage rates at 7.9000 for the ad valorem assessment and .4192 for the two (Aquatic Center and Charter School) General Obligation Bonds. These rates will be applied, along with the County and School Board millage rates, to the
