## CODE ENFORCEMENT CORNER

The Village cares about its residents and our four legged barking friends. In the interest of safety, we have been receiving complaints from residents in regards to dogs running at large or not leashed up when taken for a walk.

### SEC. 5-25. - LEASH OR OTHER CONTROL OF DOGS REQUIRED:

No dog shall be allowed upon property other than that of its owner, unless it shall be fastened to a suitable leash of dependable strength, not to exceed eight feet in length, or unless the animal is under control of the owner or other responsible person.



## BUILDING DEPARTMENT CORNER



### SEC. 6-4. - PERMITS

If you're doing construction to your home, here is a reminder that no person shall erect or construct or proceed with the erection or construction of any building or structure, nor add to, enlarge, move, improve, alter, convert, extend or demolish any building or structure, or any group of buildings and/or structures under one or joint ownership whether on one or more lots or tracts of land; or cause the same to be done where the cost of the work is \$100.00 or more in value; and on any remodeling or alteration job of any value; without first obtaining a permit therefor from the building department.



### COUNCIL INFORMATION

The October 2020 meetings will be held 6:30 PM on Tuesday, October 6th and 20th, virtually via ZOOM.

### RECENT COUNCIL ACTION

- Approved resolution, creating budget amendment #7 to the fiscal year 2019-2020 operating budgets and appropriating \$482,950 from the general fund balance for COVID-19 expenses.
- Approved resolution, amending the date of the first public hearing for the fiscal year 2020-2021 operating and capital budgets and proposed ad valorem millage rates.
- Approved resolution, authorizing the Village Manager to execute an interlocal agreement for federally-funded subawards through the Coronavirus relief.
- Approved the RFQ 2020-04-02 selection committee's highest ranking to AE Engineering, INC. and authorizing the Village Manager to negotiate a contract/fee schedule for Village Council consideration.
- Approved two proposals to help the prevention of Biscayne Bay pollution: (1) bolster educational outreach by providing weekly tips via social media and (2) coordinate virtual meetings hosted by local water experts.
- Adopted the tentative and final levying of ad valorem taxes for Miami Shores Village for the fiscal year 2020-2021 via resolution following two public hearings.
- Adopted the tentative and final budgets for fiscal year 2020-2021 via resolution in two hearings via resolution following two public hearings.
- Authorized the Village Manager to make approval, pre-approval or disapproval decisions regarding the country club management operations on behalf of the Village without the need for Village Council approval.
